Summary

Documents are objects that contain statements of fact, drawn up in writing. A document is considered to be any thing or object on which there is a written trace of the existence of an event or fact that needs to be determined as relevant for making a correct and legal decision. Documents are real, material evidence and are considered the most reliable evidence. According to the issuers, the documents are divided into public and private.

After explaining the concept and type of documents, the author paid special attention to the probative value of documents and the rules on obtaining or editing documents for proving in court. Finally, he pointed out the possibility of using electronic documents as evidence in civil proceedings.
