

## METHODS OF DETECTION OF ECONOMIC CRIME

### Abstract

The author introduces a brief explanation of the concept and main features of economic crime, highlighting the criteria by which economic crime differs from other forms of crime. In the rest of the article, the author analyses economic crimes according to the positive legislation of Bosnia and Herzegovina, emphasizing the differences that exist in content regulation of certain crimes but primarily dictated by the jurisdiction of judicial institutions and other institutions responsible for pursuit and prosecution. The central part of the article refers to the methods of detection of economic crime, where we present a brief overview of actions by authorized officials and prosecutors. The article emphasizes international criminal legal assistance and lists the preconditions necessary for its provision. In the conclusion, the obstacles regarding detection, proving and prosecution of economic crime are listed as reasons for the small number of prosecuted crimes from this area.
