OWNERSHIP – HISTORICAL DEVELOPMENT AND MODERN REGULATION IN THE CONSTITUTIONAL ORDER OF BOSNIA AND HERZEGOVINA WITH REVIEW OF THE PRACTICE OF THE ECHR

Summary: The authors investigate legal-historical aspects of the institute of ownership from the theoretical divisions of types of ownership, the understanding and development of the institution of ownership in Roman law as the basis of modern law. Different medieval understandings are analyzed, the so-called divided ownership, the work of glossators and post-glossators, and the first examples of protection of property rights against the encroachment of rulers in Europe and Croatian areas. Ownership processing follows in constitutional norms of Bosnia and Herzegovina and a review on practice of ECHR.
